

PRESS RELEASE

On March 2, 2008, Bryan C. Hipsher was taken into custody by the Hardin County Sheriff's Office on a warrant on indictment issued by Hardin County Prosecutor Bradford Bailey's Office. The indictment contains seventeen criminal counts including trafficking in heroin, possession of cocaine, possession of heroin, tampering with evidence and engaging in a pattern of corrupt activity, a felony of the first degree. Bryan C. Hipsher will be arraigned Wednesday at 2:00 in the Hardin County Court of Common Pleas.

The charges in the indictment are the result of hard work done by Detective Brian Beach of the Kenton Police Department. This is the sixth person that has recently been indicted for trafficking and or felony possession of drugs as a result of the cooperation between the Kenton Police Department and Hardin County Prosecuting Attorney Bradford Bailey's Office
